## PFAS Compliance Statement

The O-Ring Store LLC is committed to monitoring and addressing the evolving regulatory landscape surrounding per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), a broad family of thousands of substances, including fluorinated polymers such as FKM, FFKM, FVMQ, and PTFE, commonly found in our standard O-Ring compounds including:

## Conflict Materials

In August 2012, the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission adopted final rules, to implement reporting and disclosure requirements related to conflict minerals, as directed by the U.S. Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act of 2010. ## TSCA Section 6(h) Compliance Statement

This statement addresses The O-Ring Store LLC's compliance with the Regulation of Persistent, Bioaccumulative, and Toxic Chemicals under TSCA Section 6(h), as established by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).

We do not willingly or intentionally purchase, stock, or sell products containing the following substances restricted under TSCA Section 6(h):

- 2,4,6-Tris(tert-butyl)phenol (2,4,6-TTBP)

## EU Persistent Organic Pollutants (POPs) Compliance Statement

Persistent Organic Pollutants (POPs) are chemicals that remain intact in the environment for extended periods, accumulate in living organisms, and pose serious risks to human health and the ecosystem. In alignment with global efforts to reduce and eliminate POPs, The O-Ring Store LLC refers to the following regulatory frameworks:

- The Stockholm Convention, which restricts the production, use, and disposal of specific POPs.
- EU Regulation 2019/1021 on Persistent Organic Pollutants (EU POPs Regulation) and its amendment, Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2023/1608, which includes perfluorohexane sulfonic acid (PFHxS), its salts, and related compounds;
- Provisions under REACH Annex XVII, which set concentration limits for substances such as perfluorooctanoic acid (PFOA), its salts, and related compounds.

To the best of our knowledge and based on information provided by our suppliers, The O-Ring Store LLC does not intentionally purchase, stock, or sell products containing substances listed as POPs under applicable regulations. We do not conduct independent chemical testing, and this statement may be updated as supplier data, regulatory requirements, or product compositions change.

## Uyghur Forced Labor Prevention Act

At The O-Ring Store LLC, we are committed to conducting our business in strict compliance with U.S. regulations concerning forced labor, as enforced by U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP).

Under the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended by the Trade Facilitation and Trade Enforcement Act of 2015 (TFTEA), it is prohibited to import goods into the United States that are produced, in whole or in part, with forced labor. This includes convict labor, indentured labor, and forced or indentured child labor.

Additionally, the Uyghur Forced Labor Prevention Act (Public Law No. 117-78) mandates strict enforcement of the prohibition on importing goods manufactured wholly or in part with forced labor from the Xinjiang Uyghur Autonomous Region in China.

As a company that does not manufacture goods but engages in import and distribution activities, The O-Ring Store LLC ensures that all aspects of our operations, including sourcing and supply chain management, adhere strictly to these regulations.
